Getting to Japan Day and Japanese fireworks display by bus and train

The following lines take you to central stations for the fireworks display:

West of the Rhine River

- 1** **Luegplatz**
Stadtbahnen: U74, U75, U76, U77
- 2** **Jugendherberge**
Bus: 835, 836

East of the Rhine River

- 3** **Tonhalle/ Ehrenhof (U)**
Stadtbahnen: U74, U75, U76, U77
(This station is closed between 22:30 and 00:30.)
- 4** **Landtag/ Kniebrücke**
Tram: 704, 709, Bus: 835, 836, 726
- 5** **Heinrich-Heine-Allee (U)**
Stadtbahnen: U74, U75, U76, U77, U78, U79
Tram: 703, 706, 712, 713, 715
Bus: SB50, 780, 782, 785

The Rhine embankment is only a few minutes on foot from each station and will give you a clear view of the fireworks display at night.
